c. Review of Culvert Inventory – Receive staff summary of Priority 1 – "Poor" culverts identified in culvert inventory and provide direction regarding maintenance plans (ACTION)

# Summary

- 7 "Critical" Culverts + Mistler Driveway (reviewed at prior meetings)
- 10 "Priority 1 Poor" Culverts (see attached summary)
- 8 "Priority 2 Poor" Culverts (will review at future meeting)

- 11 "Priority 3 Poor" Culverts (will review at future meeting)
- 124 (estimate) "Good"
- 34 (estimate) "Excellent"

11 culverts made the "Priority 1 - Poor" list. The Board went through each culvert that was identified on the list and talked as a group about the direction of repair for each of the 11 culverts.

- 1. #104 (Westside) Board discussed and Director Bei explained that this culvert takes drainage from eastside to west and there is also a Maine Prairie culvert that takes drainage to the south. Director Viguie recommended passing on repairs, agreed to lower priority of this culvert and talk with County Public Works about maintenance
- 2. #86 (Lateral 2) Trees are on both sides of this ditch which means a lot of drip systems and micro sprinklers. Board agreed to raise the priority of this culvert and talk with County Public Works
- 3. **#74** (Lateral 2) Determined that this is a field access crossing for two different properties, must repair otherwise it will create a land lock situation. Board agreed this culvert is a high priority and talk with tenants/landowners about cost share of repairs and maintenance
- 4. #336 (Lateral 3) Plugged a lot during irrigation season. Board discussed, Director Bei stated that it's currently a buried drain Potential fix would be a 36 inch driveway culvert and convert the rest to an open ditch. Will require coordination and easement review with landowner, Solano Irrigation District and PG&E. Director Viguie agreed
- 5. **#157** (Tremont 1) Director Viguie recommended no action as culvert is providing assess to Rowe ranch.
- 6. #164 (Tremont 1) after discussion about this culvert being District responsibility or not Director Bei recommended that we should do some sort of cost share as this culvert was put in a long time ago and we don't want to start walking away now. Director Bei stated that we should do a case by case analysis and continue to do culvert replacements on ALL within the district. Director Beukelman agreed the Board agreed that we would take no action at this time, but continue to monitor.
- 7. #20 (Tremont 1) Ms. Huff is going to reach out to Yolo County Public Works about replacing this culvert.

- 8. **#181** (Tremont 1) This culvert was put in by the landowner, however the Board agrees that the district should remove it.
- 9. **#184** (Tremont 2) Recommended that the district should continue to discuss this culvert with the landowner and when the owner is ready we will bring it back to the table to discuss ongoing maintenance.
- 10. **#187** (Tremont 2) Recommended that the district should continue to discuss this culvert with the landowner and when the owner is ready we will bring it back to the table to discuss ongoing maintenance.
- 11. **#208** (Tremont 2, Lateral B) This culvert is not used very much therefore Director Viguie stated that it is not a priority and we should lower its priority. Director Viguie will continue to monitor.

A motion was made by Director Bei, seconded by Director Viguie, to implement all staff recommendations as listed above for each individual culvert listed. The motion passed as follows:
